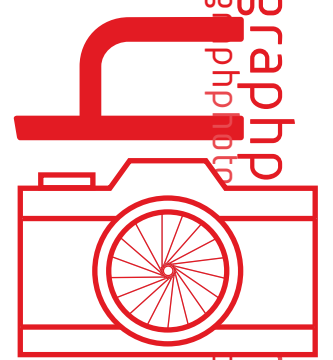

| SF CAMERAWORK |

The 2007 James D. Phelan Art Award in Photography will honor three California-born artists. In addition to a \$2,500 cash prize, each award winner is invited to participate in an exhibition at SF Camerawork.

The James D. Phelan Art Awards were established by the trust of James D. Phelan (1861-1930), former San Francisco Mayor, United States Senator, and arts supporter, to recognize the achievements of California-born artists in a variety of disciplines. The Phelan Art Award is also given in printmaking, film, and video and is part of the Arts Awards Program at The San Francisco Foundation.

SF Camerawork is a nationally recognized nonprofit artists' organization that provides a forum in which to address the broad social and aesthetic issues surrounding contemporary photography and related media.

Artistic programs and educational services include: exhibitions; *Camerawork: A Journal of Photographic Arts*; lectures; First Exposures, a photography/mentoring program; workshops and portfolio reviews; a reference library; and an active internship program.

eligibility

Application for the 2007 Award in Photography is open to any California-born artists. Current California residency is not required. Proof of birth may be requested. Past winners of the James D. Phelan Art Award in Photography are ineligible.

deadline

All entries must be received by SF Camerawork no later than 5 pm, Friday, May 4, 2007.

submissions

Please submit all of the following items:

1. Up to ten images (artist proofs or work prints) no larger than 20 x 24 inches that utilize photographic processes. Mounting and matting are permissible, but not required. Framed work will not be accepted. Slides or JPEGs on disc will be accepted for three-dimensional and/or installation work only.
2. A one-page list of the images submitted including your name, title of work, medium, and exhibition print size (if work is to be exhibited in a size larger than the submission for judging).
3. Artist statement and résumé.
4. A completed entry form (or facsimile).

Work must be delivered or arrive in a portfolio case or shipping container. Work not hand-delivered must be sent pre-paid and include return postage via the US Postal Service, Fed Ex, or UPS. In-transit insurance is not covered by SF Camerawork, and should be provided by the artist if desired.

SF Camerawork will handle all materials with extreme care, but is not responsible for loss or damage to works submitted for this award. SF Camerawork will insure only works chosen for the Phelan Exhibition during the run of the exhibition.

notification and return of work

Applicants will be notified 6-8 weeks after the submission deadline. Work will be returned or can be picked up from SF Camerawork at this time. No phone calls please.
